

1. Select a highly visible, flat surface of the case, preferably the top of a laptop or the front panel of a desktop PC, and clean the location with the alcohol swab provided. Let the alcohol dry completely. Peel the protective backing from the plate.



2. Apply a drop of gel near each corner of the plate, and two thick strips of gel over the tattoo area so the whole tattoo area will be covered by the gel when the plate is applied to the surface of the case.



Warning: Adhesive instantly bonds skin and can cause severe eye damage. Read caution statement on tube.

3. Immediately place the plate on the case of the equipment to be marked before gel begins to set. Press firmly on all four corners of the plate until you obtain a firm bond (approximately 20 seconds) - caution: the plate may slide a bit before bonding completely - then press firmly all over the plate area.



4. If excess gel appears at the edges of the plate, remove it immediately by gently scooping it away with the protective backing you peeled from the back of the plate in Step 1.



5. Apply the red warning sticker next to the plate.



ATTENTION: If the equipment is sold or returned, do not remove the plate! It would reveal a permanent marking stating: Stolen Property, and make the equipment impossible to resell.
